## **SENIOR DOGS AT THE HUMANE SOCIETY OF NORTH TEXAS FETCH GRANT**

**September 28th, 2022 – Fort Worth, Texas** – Old dogs have something to wag about this summer, as The Grey Muzzle Organization announces the recipients of its annual grants, and dogs at the Humane Society of North Texas (HSNT) are among the winners.

HSNT, headquartered in Fort Worth, Texas, is one of 78 animal welfare groups chosen from 344 applicants to receive a grant to help local senior dogs. The winning groups received more than \$705,000 in grants to help save or improve the lives of at-risk old dogs in their communities.

“This grant will help the Humane Society of North Texas give senior dogs just like 10-year-old ‘Boy-Boy’ the veterinary and dental care he needs so he’ll be ready to go to his forever home,” said director of communications, marketing, and public relations for the Humane Society of North Texas, Cassie Davidson. “No one is more grateful or loving than a senior dog, and HSNT is looking forward to helping more senior dogs get the second chance they all deserve.”

Over the past 14 years, the national nonprofit Grey Muzzle Organization has provided more than \$3.8 million in grants to support its vision of “a world where no old dog dies alone and afraid.”

“Thanks to the generosity of our donors, we’re delighted to help deserving organizations like the Humane Society of North Texas make a difference in the lives of dogs and people in their communities,” Grey Muzzle’s Executive Director Lisa Lunghofer said. “Many senior dogs in the Fort Worth are enjoying their golden years in loving homes thanks to the wonderful work of HSNT.”
