THE HUMANE SOCIETY OF NORTH TEXAS RECEIVES \$4,000 GRANT FROM PETSMART CHARITIES® TO HELP MORE HOMELESS PETS FIND HOMES IN FORT WORTH

Free adoptions were offered during National Adoption Week and helped find homes for 66 pets

Fort Worth, TX – July 27, 2022 –The Humane Society of North Texas (HSNT) has received a \$4,000 grant from [PetSmart Charities](#) to help prepare more pets in Fort Worth, Texas for adoption. Some five million pets make their way into shelters each year in the U.S. With the help of this grant, HSNT offered free adoptions on all dogs over six months and 30 pounds and cats over six months of age during the PetSmart National Adoption Week at the [PetSmart locations at Bryant Irvin, Lake Worth, Montgomery Plaza](#), and [Ridgmar](#) from July 11 to July 17, 2022. In total, 66 pets found forever homes through adoption efforts by HSNT; 43 cats and 23 dogs now have new families!

“The Humane Society of North Texas is always thrilled to participate in PetSmart Charities National Adoption Week as these events generate so much excitement in regards to adopting shelter pets,” said Cassie Davidson, Director of Communications, Marketing, & Public Relations. “Our goal is to continue adopting as many dogs, cats, and small animals into homes. Shelters across the nation have been struggling with overcapacity, so by adopting you are in essence saving two lives—the life of the pet you’ve adopted, and by opening additional shelter space for a pet in need.”

PetSmart Charities is the leading funder of animal welfare in North America, granting more than \$500 million since its inception in 1994, and recently surpassed 10 million pet adoptions in partnership with local animal welfare organizations like the North Texas Humane Society.
