Humane Society of North Texas Helps Rescue Texas Gulf Coast Pets Before Hurricane Laura Hits

Who: The Humane Society of North Texas

Where: Fort Worth, Texas

Why: The Humane Society of North Texas (HSNT) is working with several groups to rescue more than 90 pets from the Texas Gulf Coast before Hurricane Laura hits.

When: HSNT is coordinating with Wings of Rescue and GreaterGood.org to fly 80 pets from the Texas Gulf Coast to the Meacham Airport today. This flight will carry 56 cats, 20 dogs, 3 rabbits and a 3-legged mouse named Pipsqueak out of harm's way to safety here in North Texas. All of the pets are coming from the Houston SPCA, which picked up the dogs and cats from the Galveston Island Humane Society. The rescue flight is expected to land at around 2:00 p.m. today, August 25th, 2020. HSNT will be placing most of the pets up for adoption and the SPCA of Texas will assist by taking about 20 cats.

HSNT will also be receiving 12 dogs from the Humane Society of Southeast Texas in Beaumont via ground transport around noon today.

"The Humane Society of North Texas is always eager to help pets in need, especially when a devastating hurricane is barreling toward the Gulf Coast," said Cassie Davidson, HSNT Director of Communications. "The North Texas community has been amazing in their response to saving pets during COVID-19 and we know they will do the same with Hurricane Laura."
