\$100,000 in Funding Has Saved More than 2,600 Lives So Far During the COVID-19 Pandemic!

Who: The Humane Society of North Texas

Where: Fort Worth, Texas

Why: The Humane Society of North Texas (HSNT) received a total of \$100,000 in funding from PetSmart Charities, Inc., the Amon G. Carter Foundation, Nestle Purina, the North Texas Community Foundation, an anonymous matching donor, as well as the individual donors to the Communities Foundation of Texas through the North Texas Giving Tuesday Now Campaign, for the pets in HSNT's care during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The impact of these donations has allowed HSNT to save more than 2,600 lives so far by providing supplies to over 400 emergency foster heroes, as well as helping over 2,250 pets find their forever homes during this unprecedented time of COVID-19. Grants and donations helped purchase foster supplies such as leashes, beds, food, medication, newborn formula, scales and endless other essential materials. This crisis has shown how strong the North Texas community cares about homeless pets by adopting so many furry friends during these challenging times. HSNT thanks each organization and the thousands of caring individuals who made these lifesaving efforts possible.
