



LOCAL DALLAS PET FOSTER VOLUNTEERS RECEIVE DELIVERY OF DONATED PET GOODS TO HELP THEM #STAYHOMEANDFOSTER
Local Donation is Part of National Movement to Help Homeless Dogs and Cats

WHO: Local pet foster volunteers from the [Humane Society of North Texas](#) and the [SPCA of Texas](#) will begin receiving foster kits with donated pet supplies from [GreaterGood.org](#) and delivered free-of-charge via [Wag! Now](#), to help them [#StayHomeAndFoster](#). #StayHomeAndFoster is a national effort created by GreaterGood.org in partnership with NBCUniversal Owned Television Stations' Clear The Shelters™ campaign and sponsored by the US Animal Health Business of Boehringer Ingelheim to provide support for pets, people, animal shelters and animal rescue groups who have been affected by the COVID-19 pandemic.

WHAT: Pet Caregivers on the WAG! Now platform will pick up donated pet foster kits for dogs from the Humane Society of North Texas as well as the SPCA of Texas and deliver them to approximately 200 local volunteer pet foster homes throughout the Dallas area. The contents of the pet foster kits are contributed through The Animal Rescue Site and include food bowls, collars, leashes, treats, toys, and poop bags. When needed, dogs will also be delivered with the foster kits.

WHY: In an effort to support the #StayHomeAndFoster movement, Wag! Now will help transport foster pets and donated supplies from animal shelters to pet foster homes. Wag! Now is a service that provides socially distanced pet transportation, pet food delivery, and special needs pet services.
