42 Guinea Pigs Rescued from Deplorable Conditions Are Available for Adoption This Saturday!

Who: The Humane Society of North Texas

Where: PetSmart at Montgomery Plaza, 415 Carroll St., Fort Worth, TX 76107, and PetSmart at Southlake, 200 S. Village Center Dr., Southlake, TX 76092

When: Saturday, July 11th, 11 a.m.–3 p.m.

Why: On June 18th, 2020, the Humane Society of North Texas (HSNT) assisted City of Denton authorities in rescuing 124 small pets from a home filled with over 600 pounds of waste. HSNT is happy to report that 42 of the guinea pigs saved from the incredibly inhumane and dire conditions are available for immediate adoption *this* Saturday! Some of the small pets from this seizure are still receiving medical attention and will be available soon. The remaining small animals were transferred to other rescue organizations for adoption. HSNT's goal is to find lifelong, loving homes for all 42 guinea pigs in one day! Several of the guinea pigs are bonded pairs and must be adopted together.
